Neuzil To Hold September Government and You Listening Posts

(IOWA CITY IA) Terrence Neuzil, member of the Johnson County Board of Supervisors, will hold his "Government and You" Listening Posts in September. The listening posts last one hour and provide residents an opportunity to discuss local, state and national government issues in an informal setting. Each month during the listening posts, citizens also can learn and discuss a hot and emerging issue that Johnson County is facing. In September, the Hot Topics Discussion will be on the Johnson County Integrated Roadside Vegetation Management Plan. This relatively new county plan is the first in the state of Iowa that in part encourages the preservation of useful ecologically integrated roadside plantings with visual interest, all while maintaining safety in the right of way. Currently, 11 rural families participate in roadside plans adjacent to their property that include protection from county chemical sprayings.
