NEUZIL PLANS '08 RE-ELECTION

IOWA CITY IA -- Johnson County Supervisor Terrence Neuzil has announced his plans to run for re-election to the Board of Supervisors. The 38-year-old two term incumbent is credited for working with government officials to develop some of the most aggressive projects and programs in Johnson County history.

Neuzil was instrumental in the creation of the County Campus Plan which calls for a new three-story Health and Human Services building to be finished in fall of 2008. The project, to include LEED Environmental Certification, will house nearly ten county departments and will include a skywalk into the existing County Administration Building on South Dubuque Street in Iowa City. Neuzil has also supported plans for a new SEATS – Secondary Roads Facility, a joint Communications Center, and addressing jail overcrowding issues with an award winning mental health diversion program and substance abuse program. Neuzil's work to create the Johnson-Linn Leadership Summit helped initiate the first county trails plan that will connect Iowa City to Cedar Rapids. Neuzil also was a key player in protecting farmers and residents in the North Corridor by stopping the environmentally destructive Newport Road and Prairie Du Chien Road Projects.

Since taking office in 2000, Johnson County has worked to develop the County's first Strategic Plan, Economic Development Plan, County Farm Plan, Courthouse Security Plan, Human Rights Ordinance, Tobacco Use Policy, Sensitive Areas Ordinance, and the Cool Counties Environmental Initiative. In addition, the county has increased public safety and the Sheriff Patrol Division, and has invested over 10 million dollars in human service and public health prevention programs. Neuzil has also held over 350 "Government and You" Listening Posts to encourage more citizen participation.

GOALS OUTLINED FOR THIRD TERM

- ✓ Continue to improve county services for the public and employee working conditions and productivity by completing the Health and Human Services Building, the SEATS-Secondary Roads Facility, the Joint Communications Center, Administration Building remodeling project, new Conservation Office and Maintenance Facility, and a new Justice Center to include a larger jail alternatives program and improved courthouse security
- ✓ Update the Land Use Plan with more protections for family farmers and our environment, including a commitment to clean our creeks and the Iowa River
- ✓ Develop a Metro Transportation Plan, improve gravel and dirt roads, pave wider shoulders where appropriate, and build a separated pedestrian and bicycle trail from Iowa City to Cedar Rapids
- ✓ Support a health and human service network to includes a minimum \$5 million investment to prevention programs for children and seniors
- ✓ Expand programs on diversity, human rights, Spanish in the workplace, the arts and rural economic development
- ✓ Complete 200 more "Government and You" Listening Posts to promote citizen participation
